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DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1

07:00am-17:00pm: Travel from Johannesburg to Dullstroom - Panorama Route - Hazy View (travel time is 11 hours with a stop at Middelburg for bathroom and coffee at own cost)

About Dullstroom-the Panorama Route and Hazy view

- Depart from the City of Johannesburg to Mpumalanga the province where the sun rises at 05:00 am.
- The stop at the town of Dullstroom is known for its crystal-clear dams, fishing, and outdoor activity. We stop for refreshments (at own cost) and to stretch our legs before continuing.
- We will get to experience the Blyde River Canyon, which is a 26km long Canyon located in Mpumalanga, South Africa. It is the third-largest canyon on Earth, behind the Grand Canyon and the Fish River Canyon. Unlike the Grand and Fish River Canyon, the Blyde River Canyon is a green canyon which is dominated by subtropical vegetation.
- God's Window will be also another stop for a picturesque viewpoint. Uniquely located North of Graskop, while standing at this viewpoint you get a beautiful view of the panoramic lowveld. You will be able to view the magnificent Blyde River Canyon.
- The Berlin Falls are a waterfall in Mpumalanga, South Africa. They are located close to God's Window and are the highest waterfall in South Africa's Mpumalanga province.
- Bourke's Luck Potholes will also be amongst the best of Mpumalanga attractions as a popular geological attraction formed by water erosion, with walkways & bridges that take one's breath away.
- Three Rondavels is also amongst the offerings. There are Three Rondavels which are three round mountain tops with slightly pointed tops, remarkably like the traditional round or oval African homesteads made with local materials and are called rondavels. Once known as the chief and his three wives - the flat-topped peak represented Mapjaneng, famous for opposing invading Swazis in a memorable battle, whilst the rondavels are three of his more troublesome wives - Magabolle, Mogoladikwe, and Maseroto
- After our time at the Panorama Route, we make our way to Hazyview which is where our overnight accommodation is.

Day 2

05:00am-16:00pm: Kruger National Park Full Day Safari

About the Full Day Safari

- With departure from the accommodation estimated at 5.30 am. This promises to be the climax of our wildlife experience. The Kruger National full Day safari!
- An early morning safari provides an opportunity to see what wildlife does in the morning, particularly the cat family, which is constantly on the quest for their next meal. Various creatures will return from hunts, and this is the ideal time to witness them in action.
- We will arrive at the nearest gate, ready to be ushered early in the morning and experience wildlife at the various stages of the day. We will explore the park for the whole day with a quick popping to have breakfast and Lunch at the famous Skukuza Camp Located inside the Kruger National Park.
- Our day will end at around 4 pm when we depart from the park and head back to our accommodation in Hazy View and reflect on the wonderful day we had.

Day 3-Hazyview-Johannesburg-Cape Town

About the Morning Safari

- We will rise early in the morning for our morning safari and get ready to jump inside the park as earliest as possible to get a feel of what this wildlife does in the wee hours of the morning.
- This also serves us an opportunity to see what wildlife does in the morning and especially the cat family who are always hunting their next meal. Various creatures will be coming back from hunts, and this will be the perfect time to see them in action.
- We will also get an opportunity to have our pre-packed breakfast prepared from the hotel and experience the best 4 hours in the morning.

10:00am-11:00am: Return to overnight accommodation to collect luggage and check out.

11:00am-16:00 pm: Travel from Kruger National Park (with one pit stop for bathroom and lunch at own cost at Middleburg) to Johannesburg
